



Message of ECTUN on Ukrainian crisis

The global community should resist the power of arms and the challenge to borders and international treaties. The civilisation and conquests of the 21st century must not allow the world to return to the violent conditions of other eras and to armed solutions to inter-state disputes.

Europe has suffered too much from these concepts. Historical revisionism with the use of weapons must be opposed by the entire democratic world.

What is happening in Ukraine it is a problem that is pan-European and therefore requires a pan-European solution.

For, in the Ukrainian crisis many things are being tested: the limits of international law, the validity of the Treaties and the very right of states to live freely.

ECTUN a network of European Capitals and Regions whose people are the first to suffer from war hostilities call for an immediate ceasefire in Ukraine, and starting of good-faith negotiations in order to resolve the crisis in the interest of people.

To all those who suffer we express our solidarity and we ask the involved leaders to give peace a chance. It is crucial.
